#### **PROJECT SUMMARY**

Kiboome Christopher borehole was drilled in 1995, it has served the community for 28 years and since 1995 the source had never been rehabilitated. Being in service for many years, the borehole had silted, which affected the borehole yield. Also, being works from 28 years ago, spare parts of the borehole are off market during these years which has resulted into malfunctions of the borehole due to faults in hardware parts with no available replacements.

With your contributions, we have been able to restore the borehole, installed it with U2 stainless pipes and clean water is available to the community with no worry of any technical faults.

A permanent fence has also been provided to keep animals away from contaminating the borehole area.
